

The New KEXP Offers Music That Matters to Everyone

With daily tours and open recording sessions, KEXP's new space, opening April 16 at Seattle Center, is a music-loving family's best friend

Local, independent radio station <u>KEXP</u> not only expanded its square footage with its recent move to Seattle Center, it expanded the very definition of community radio. For the first time, the homegrown favorite will be open to the public, offering daily tours, open recording sessions and more perks to music-loving families and fans.

Details are still in the works for future community partnerships and family-friendly activities — much depends on the ongoing capital campaign, says KEXP annual giving and events coordinator Tilly Rodina — but one event is already on the books: **the (free!) grand opening** from noon to 9 p.m. Saturday, April 16.

KEXP grand opening highlights

First, location: KEXP's new digs are at 472 First Ave., at the corner of First and Republican, near (appropriately) the Vera Project and the SIFF Film Center.

The grand opening schedule on April 16 is packed with all-ages fun. Here are highlights:

- Expect (of course) live music. Groups including <u>Bob Mould</u>, <u>Hey Marseilles</u>, <u>Samaris</u> and more will perform inside KEXP and in the courtyard outside the HQ's giant garage doors.
- The courtyard will feature food trucks and a beer garden (with ID). Keep an eye out for Teatro ZinZanni contortionist and hula-hoop artist Vita Radionova (2 p.m.) with free tours every 15 minutes.
- Neighboring all-ages arts venue <u>The Vera</u>
 <u>Project</u> will also host family-friendly shows
 while next door, the <u>SIFF Film</u>

<u>Center</u> will screen Seattle music videos. At 8 p.Kidpwillfalsockere the transmit laser

installation in an expension polyment of the KEXP building; "Inside the Music of KEXP" is a room-sized sculpture hung with what looks like mesh fabric. Visitors can touch the fabric, wired with Microsoft's Kinect technology, and "remix" songs. You've got to see it to believe it.

• For snacks, <u>La Marzocco</u> café will be open for business in the Gathering Space ("lobby" doesn't do it justice) while <u>Molly Moon's</u> will be selling a special "Cheryl Waters Middae Sundae" (vanilla ice cream hot fudge, candieded hazelnuts, whipped cream and a cherry — hungry yet?). <u>Theo Chocolate</u> got in on the sweet action, too; pick up their limited edition KEXP Sound Bar.

KEXP any day: Open recording sessions, tours and more

Following the grand opening, you can still get a peek at what's going on at KEXP any day of the week.

Free tours and open viewing of the DJ booth: Free tours will start daily at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m., and the couch-strewn Gathering Space will be open to the public. Beside La Marzocco, the Gathering Space's main attraction is direct access to the inside workings of KEXP. Two windows look into the DJ booth where you can see the music you're hearing.

Open recording sessions: And let's not forget the viewing room. Following April 16, KEXP is opening its performance recording sessions — nearly 500 a year — to the public as free,

all-ages shows. The sessions, which generally last 20 to 40 laundry and couches big minutes, are scheduled at all times of day and night, but most enough to nap on. frequently at noon. Check the schedule, then show up day of the show to get on the viewing list (about 70 people can fit in the viewing room).

Now, instead of paying for tickets and a babysitter, parents can bring their kids with them to see all their favorite local and touring acts. Just look at some of <u>the in-studio performances</u> KEXP hosted in the weeks leading up to April 16.
